- The parties agree that nothing herein is intended to nor shall it be construed as creating recognition of or bargaining with a multi-employer bargaining unit other than those already recognized by the Local Union and limited to the geographical jurisdiction of the Local Unions.
- This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect through April 30, 2003, and shall continue nereafter unless there has been sixty (60) days written notice, by registered or certified mail, by either party hereto of the desire to modify and amend this Agreement for negotiations. The EMPLOYER and the UNION agree to be bound by the area-wide negotiated contracts with the various Associations, incorporating them into this Memorandum of Agreement and extending this Agreement for the life of the newly negotiated contract, if not notified within the specified period of time.
- 9. The EMPLOYER acknowledges and accepts the facsimile signatures on this contract as if they
